Deed of Trust between Thomas Hargrave of the first part James Clayton of the second part and James E Clayton of the third part, conveying two horses two cows and furniture one beef and a whole and one cow and calf was proved in the Clerk's office on the 18th January 1821 by George W Spring Thomas J Bristle and James Vick the witnesses thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Frances M Bopkin and Helen Ann his wife to Elizabeth C Briggs conveying ^{their interest in} a tract of 100 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's office the 18th January 1821 by Francis M Bopkin and together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Records.

Deed of Trust between Benjⁿ Branch of the first part Andrew B Vaughan of the second part and John Vaughan and others of the third part conveying 65 acres of land negro man and Peter one horse all my Stock of hogs Cattle &c. household and kitchen furniture crop of corn potatoes &c. spanning Utensils and one still cup and mortar was proved in the Clerk's office the 18th January 1821 by J L Bailey Robertus Holt and Alfred J Bristle the witnesses thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edward M Philis and wife to Polly Bristle conveying a tract of 100 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's office the 18th January 1821 by John Bopkin Samuel M Holmes and Thomas Plummer the witnesses thereto and admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Patrick B Durrell to Thomas Partlow Shiff conveying a tract of 262 acres of land was returned to the Clerk's office on the 18th January 1821 with a Certificate unsworn of the acknowledgment thereof before the County Court of Delawar and together with the said Certificate admitted to Records.

Deed of bargain and sale from Reuben Darwood and Mary his wife to Clements Rochelle conveying a tract of 75 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's office the 21st January 1821 by Frederick J Mathews one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 16th January 1821 by H J Smith and on the 17th August 1820 by James Mudgett two other
