Whereupon the said Alfred S Bailey with James B Urquhart Richards & Urquhart & Robert Murray his Neatly entered into & acknowledged a bond on the penalty of One hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of attorney on the estate of the said James Scott dec^d with his said will annexed in due form.

Yet upon this condition that the said Solomon Johnson shall keep the peace & be of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards John J Holland & William Howell for the space of twelve months from the day when the above recognized to be void or else to remain in full force?

On motion of James Clayton attorney of Silas Summerville dec^d Ordered that Silas R Edwards who is a duly appointed Com^r for the purpose state with & adjust Silas Summerville's account w^t Charles M Godfrey & make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Overseers Madison Margaret & Braminita children of Avery Warren free negro to Polly Brithell according to Law conveanting with the said Polly Brithell that she pay to the mother of 5th children the sum of £5^{per annum} for each child except the last year apprenticeship the sum are to be paid to said apprentices respectively.

Samuel T James appointed Constable in the Upper district of Notchway Parish in the County of Franklin 1842 & thereupon he gave bond with security before the authority by Law which bond was acknowledged & recorded. It appearing to the Court that the said James is a man of honesty, probity & good demeanor.
