Deed of bargain and sale from Colton W. Bunn, attorney in fact for Peter Fendall to Henry Winard conveying a tract of ^{more or less} land was proved in the Clerk's office the 5th of May by the oath of Edward Beaton Lunsford Beaton and John F. Kemmerle the witnesses thereto and submitted to Record -

Deed of lease from Benjamin B. Phillips to Joseph B. Butler bearing ^{more or less} and was acknowledged in the Clerk's office the 5th of May 1841 by Benjamin B. Phillips and Joseph B. Butler. The parties thereto and submitted to Record -

Deed of tract between William Barson and Mary his wife of the one part Matthew W. Paughard of the second part and James Kelly of the third part, ^{conveying a tract of 544 acres of land more or less} was acknowledged in the Clerk's office the 5th of May 1841 by William Barson and Matthew W. Paughard two of the parties thereto and together with the Certificate annexed of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife, submitted to Record -

Deed of bargain and sale from John A. Turner and Martha his wife to Anthony A. Williams conveying one ^{more or less} variety of uncertain lot or parcel of land situate in and adjacent to the tract of 79 1/2 acres of land, ^{more or less} together with all the fixtures and furniture was acknowledged in the Clerk's office the 11th of May 1841 by John A. Turner and together with the Certificate of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife submitted to Record -

The account current of Nicholas W. Abbotts administration in Henry Sumner's est. of James Williams administrator of Mary Williams' estate, of James Williams administrator of George Williams' est. & of Sarah Ferguson administrator of Ferguson's estate having severally been on file and no exceptions being filed was confirmed & ordered to be recorded. On this motion of Samuel Drury who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law a lease is granted him to keep said estate and premises at his residence in this County till May next next.

Dingley, the subscribing witnesses thereto, & Ordered to be recorded. James A. Williams et al. Executors named refusing to take up on themselves the burden of showing the truth of the same. On the motion of George B. Holloman who made oath & gave bond & security according to law to take said certificate as required from him for obtaining letters of administration with the Will annexed on the said John A. Williams. Ordered that Thomas M. Dingley, John F. Gwaltney, Charles Reed & Thomas A. Williams & any 3 of them being sworn & appraised, said estate &
