Phillips and Rebecca his wife to Alexander Mayrhoke conveying a tract of 74 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of James Mayrhoke one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 17th day of April 1841 by the oath of Jacob Barnes and William D. Phillips his other witnesses thereto and together with the Certificate of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from David Bryant to James Mayrhoke conveying a tract of 9 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the said David Bryant and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John Mayrhoke of the first part Seth D. Williams of the second part and Jesse Parker of the third part conveying all his household and kitchen furnitures 1 Cow &c. &c. all his farming utensils & chest of tools &c. &c. of David Mayrhoke's personal property &c. was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by John Mayrhoke Seth D. Williams and Jesse Parker the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Pledge Carrow of the first part Alexander Mayrhoke of the second part and David Bryant of the third part conveying conveying three Cows and all his household and kitchen furnitures all his stock of horses hogs &c. Apple mill and pigs farming utensils &c. was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by Pledge Carrow Alexander Mayrhoke and David Bryant the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Jesse J. Parker and Edith his wife to James Mayrhoke conveying a tract of 3 1/2 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of James Mayrhoke Alexander Mayrhoke and Jacob Williams the witnesses thereto and together with the Certificate of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William Mayrhoke of the first part James P. French of the second part & Samuel Mayrhoke of the third part conveying one negro man and land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by William Mayrhoke and James P. French two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Augustus J. Westbrooke and Emily his wife to Joseph Mayrhoke conveying a tract of 133 1/2 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of Edwin B. Claus one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 17th day of April 1841 by the oath of William French and Solomon J. Parker his other witnesses thereto and together with the Certificate of the proper examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Davis and Catherine his wife Jacob Tucker and Peter his wife to Guly former conveying a tract of 25 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of Jeremiah Goyner Nathan Turner and Jeremiah Goyner the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.
