

Deed of trust between Levi Miller of the first part James B. Lundy of the second part and Nathaniel Francis of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 500 acres more or less also the following slaves, Joseph, Willis, Nancy, Jacob, Fanny, Fannie, Jack, Bally Henry and Dred was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 25th day of June 1831 by James B. Lundy and Levi Miller two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James C. Brighton of the first part Liberator R. Edwards of the second part and Richard Hutchinson of the third part conveying one acre by name shown and about 16 acres was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 25th day of June 1831 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Bernice S. Griffin and Susan his wife to Catherine Kitchin conveying a tract of land containing 9 acres 1 Rod and 2 poles was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 3rd day of July 1831 by Bernice S. Griffin and together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Holt. v. Holt & Co. Chy. - This cause came on this day to be heard upon the report formerly made and on report of the four referees made at the last Term to which no exception has been filed and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court approving and confirming the said report with a proviso order and decree that the same be held from Holt and binding between Holt being waived to the infant defendants to show cause if any day can against this decree ^{within six months} after they respectively attain the age of twenty one year.
