Deed of trust between James James of the first part Edward J Turner of the second part and Simon T Mather of the third part conveying Conveying two negroes Girl Mary and boy Henry was proved in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James James of the first part Thomas A Mather of the second part and John Jay and James D Mather of the third part conveying one negro woman named Elizabeth Briggs Anthony and child and two Girls Martha and Susan which is female children was proved in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from William B Bowdoyne to William Bowdoyne conveying a tract of Land containing 50 more or less was returned to the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 and together with the Certificate ~~admitted~~ admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William Prier Reiss P Travis and Henry Lewis conveying to William B Bowdoyne conveying a tract of Land containing 36 1/2 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by Reiss P Travis one of the parties thereto and having been before acknowledged on the 20th July 1820 by William Prier another party thereto it is admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Johnson Corbit of the first part Joseph A Johnson of the second part and Benjamin Griffin of the third part conveying 1 bay mare 2 foalies brn and parrish 5 lbs sheep 2 head of cattle and 13 head of hogs was proved in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved on the 17th day of May 1821 by two other witnesses thereto is admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Hunt to Benjamin E Pope conveying a tract of Land containing 15 acres more or less was proved in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of release from J^r P Richard to Henry B Vaughan releasing a certain plantation ~~unrecorded in said Court~~ was acknowledged in the Clerks office on the 19th day of July 1821 by the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
