Isom a negro man Slave belonging to Burrill Williams of this County who hath been committed to the Jail of this County charged with entering the house of Mason Pope by removing the fastening of the window Sash of said house feloniously taking and carrying away the following property to wit, three Ladies dresses, three dresses of a smaller size, five dollars & 20 Cents in Cash, one silk handkerchief, two lawn collars one counterpane black Coffee pot four yards of Calico, bed quilt about half finished and one pair Cotton Stockings, the whole value amounting to thirty dollars Seventy five Cents - was set to the bar in custody of the Jailor of this Court (the Court summoned for this trial having failed to meet) and the prisoner being duly arraigned pleaded not guilty. Whereupon printing notices were sworn out & examined and the prisoner by his counsel fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the felony of which he stands charged and proclamation being made as the manner is & nothing further appearing or being alleged
