Articles of agreement made and entered into between Edwin Gray and Anne Gray widow of B. B. Gray was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th day of August 1841 by Edwin Gray one of the parties thereto and was admitted to Record -

Deed of bargain and sale from Hurling N. Larrin and Sally & his wife to William H. Bell conveying a tract of land containing 85 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 26th August 1841 by the said Hurling N.
