

Deed of bargain and sale from Bennett & Griffin and Thacker his wife to Edward Wilkins conveying a part of a tract of Land containing 9 acres 1 rood and 2 poles was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 31st August 1841 by the said Bennett & Griffin and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgments of the wife again submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John D. Sumner of the first part William S. G. Lord of the second part & Nicholas de Selous of the third part conveying 1 cow and calf 13 hours of hogs one bay mare 2 fatherless and furnished and all the other household and kitchen furniture and growing crops was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 6th day of September 1841 by one of the parties thereto & having been before acknowledged in the office on the 1st day of September 1841 by the other two parties was submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between George Johnson of the first part, Randolph Porter of the second part and John C. Richardson of the third part. Conveying one bed and furniture was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 6th day of September 1841 by all the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James D. Drake of the first part Thomas J. Postow of the second part and Thomas Postow of the third part conveying a tract of Land containing 294 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's office on the 13th September 1841 by all the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

An account of Edward Butler's accounts of John W. Bailey was returned & ordered to be recorded.

The account current & summary report of William Hancock administrator of James C. Hancock & Co. having been one term and no exceptions being filed was confirmed & recorded.

Account current & summary report of Thomas Brothers administrators of John M. Weston estate of James D. Mappinburgs administrator of Thomas Applebush estate of James D. Mappinburgs administrator of Henry Applebush estate of James D. Mappinburgs administrator of William Applebush estate were ordered to lie one term for exceptions.

Quincy Hall vs. Butler & Co. Chy. This cause came on this day to be further heard upon the papers formerly read and the report of the commissioners made at the last term to which no exception has been filed and was argued by counsel. On consideration thereof the Court affirming the said report doth adjudge order and decree that the division aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and binding between the parties.

Account current & summary report of Saml. H. Holmes executor on Chas. Freeman & Co. was ordered to lie one term for exceptions.

Ordered that Henry Pittman vs. William Thomas Minor & Rachel Jellis is set off of them let the return of a writ of sequestrum be made as soon as possible.

Peter B. Broun who has been duly licensed to practice the law in the Court of this Commonwealth on his motion has leave to practice in this Court and thereupon he took the oath required by law. On the motion of Edward C. Crumpler. Ordered that the Clerk of this Court receive of the said Crumpler the amount of his retainer & interest therein which was filed in the office of this Court as a part of the sale of William Porter's land and in the proportion of John Porter's land sales and deliver the said Crumpler said land upon his paying the amount thereof to the Clerk.
