That the Constable make sale of the attached effects ordered upon a credit until the said 1st day of January next take bond and good security of the purchaser upon the same over to the p^{er}ff^t in satisfaction of his judgment and the balance return to the Deft. and make return thereof to the Court

Be it remembered that Richmond Edwards with Thomas Norcross & Stephen Beale his Securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rushford Esq. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Richmond Edwards in the sum of \$100. and the said Securities in the sum of \$50 each of their respective good & valuable bonds & covenants to be levied and to the said acting Governor and his Successor in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Richmond Edwards shall keep the peace and be of good behavior toward all the Citizens of the Commonwealth more especially toward Elizabeth Watkins of this County then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Turner give security for his keeping the peace for the space of twelve months from this day that is to say the said John A. Turner to be bound in the sum of \$100. with two Securities in the sum of \$50. each. Whereupon the said John A. Turner with Thomas & Jones & John W. Rockelle his Securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rushford Esq. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said Richard A. Edwards in the sum of \$100. and the said Jones & Rockelle's in the sum of \$50. each of their respective good & valuable bonds & covenants to be levied and to the said Governor & his Successor in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said John A. Turner & c shall keep the peace and be of good behavior toward all the Citizens of this Commonwealth for the Term of 12 months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue.
