Whereupon the said John A Turner with Thomas Lawrence & John M Rockelle his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esq<sup>r</sup> Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said John A Turner £100 and the said John M Rockelle £50 in the sum of £50 each of their respective good & challdes land & Revenue to be levied and to the said Governor & his successor in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Agt upon the condition that if the said John A Turner shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the Term of 12 months from the day where this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force & valid.

Nancy Whitfield orphan of Charles Whitfield late made claim of Bennett H Whitfield for her maintenance and thereupon the said Bennett H Whitfield gave bond with security according to Law.
