

for the Term of twelve months from this day. Whereupon the said William J. Connell  
with Joseph G. Connel & James M. Connell his security hereon Cont severally acknowledged  
themselves indebted unto John Rutherford by Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of  
the Commonwealth of Virginia the said William J. Connell in the sum of \$300 and the  
said Joseph G. Connel & James M. Connell in the sum of \$100 each of their respective goods  
of Chattels, Lands and Tenements to be levied on, & the said Governor & his Successors in the  
Office of Governor for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this Condition that  
of the said William J. Connell shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all  
the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Patrick Dole for the space  
of twelve months from this day when this recognizance to be void.

Joseph Goyne who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer  
the Complaint of William Garrison against him for a breach of the peace appeared in  
Court in discharge of his recognizance and the said William Garrison being sworn in  
and the said Goyne by Connell fully heard the Court after hearing the Testimony are of  
opinion & do therefore order that the said Goyne give security for his future peace for  
the Term of twelve months from this day - that is to say the said Goyne is to be bound in  
the sum of \$50 with 2 securities in the sum of \$50 each and that he pay the Costs of  
this prosecution. And whereupon the said Goyne with James A. French and  
William A. Spark his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted  
unto John Rutherford by Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth  
of Virginia the said Joseph Goyne in the sum of \$200 and the said Connell the  
sum of \$100 each of their respective goods & Chattels lands & Tenements to be levied on to  
the said Governor and his Successors in Office for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.  
Yet upon this Condition that the said Joseph Goyne shall keep the peace the  
of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially to a  
man William Garrison for the Term of 12 months from the day when this recognizance  
to be void.

James M. Connell who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to  
answer the Complaint of Patrick Dole against him for a breach of the peace appeared  
in discharge of his recognizance - Whereupon it is ordered that the said Complainant be  
discharged and that Patrick Dole the prosecutor pay the Costs of this prosecution -
