

for the term of twelve months from this day. and that he do pay the costs of this prosecution
with Joseph by Council & James M. Council has security here in Court severally acknowledged
themselves in debt unto John Rutherford Esq. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of
the Commonwealth of Virginia the said William J. Council in the sum of \$200 and the
said Joseph by Council & James M. Council in the sum of \$100. each of their respective goods
& chattels, lands and tenements to be seized in & to the said Governor & his Successors in the
Office of Governor for the use of the Commonwealth reserved. Yet upon this Condition that
if the said William J. Council shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all
the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Patrick Dole for the space
of twelve months from this day then this recognizance to be void -

Forasmuch as James Foster who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer
the Complaint of William Garner against him for a breach of the peace appeared in
Court on discharge of his recognizance - and the said William Garner being sworn & examined
and the said Foster by Council fully heard. The Court after hearing the Testimony of
opinion & do therefore order that the said Foster give security for keeping the peace for
the term of twelve months from this day - that is to say the said Foster to be bound in
the sum of \$20. with 2 Securies in the sum of \$20 each and that he pay the costs of
this prosecution - And that upon the said Foster with James S. Hornick & the
William at Sparks has security here in Court severally acknowledged themselves in debt
unto John Rutherford Esq. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth
of Virginia the said James Foster in the sum of \$20 and the said Securies in the
sum of \$10 each of their respective goods & chattels, lands & tenements to be seized in & to
the said Governor and his Successors in Office to the use of the Commonwealth reserved.
Yet upon this Condition that if the said James Foster shall keep the peace & be
of good behaviour towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially to a
man William Garner for the term of 12 months from this day then this recognizance
to be void -

James M. Council who at our Court by recognizance for his appearance here to
answer the Complaint of Patrick Dole against him for a breach of the peace appeared
on discharge of his recognizance - Whereupon it is ordered that the said Complaint be
dismissed and that Patrick Dole the prosecutor pay the costs of this prosecution -
On the motion of Nicholas M. Schell who made oath & gave bond with security and
being to Law Certificate & promises him for obtaining Letters of a new & solemnly sworn
in the form

Ordered that the account of Bay & C. Everett amounting to \$136 & of Abraham

examination & payment
