Deed of Release from Jesse Drury trustee of E. to Edward Turner releasing a tract of Land containing 70 Acres was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 15th November 1821 by the said Jesse Drury & submitted to Record -

Deed of bargain and sale from Edward Turner and Annis his wife to James Hickey conveying a tract of Land containing 70 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 15th November 1821 by Edward Turner and together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife submitted to Record -

Deed of bargain and sale from Jeremiah Goyner and Temperance his wife & John H. Herring conveying a tract of Land containing 100 Acres more or less was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 15th November 1821 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the office on the 16th August 1821 by two other witnesses thereto and was acknowledged in the said office on the 22nd day of same month by one of the parties thereto was together with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife submitted to Record -
