The Clerk this day returned the following List of Deeds &c. admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of this Court since December Term 1841. (Viz.)

1. Deed of Trust between Burwell Norrell of the first part Benjamin C. Pope of the second part and Henry Rindell of the third part conveying a tract of Land containing 61 1/2 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

2. Deed of bargain and sale from John of Prince Canaboe of Joseph Blumley and John of P. Pennington conveying a tract of Land containing 682 Acres more or less, was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in said Office on the 13th same month by two other witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

3. Deed of bargain and sale from Elizabeth Willing and Elizabeth his wife and Dorothy Willing & Mary Jones conveying a tract of Land containing 10 Acres and 2 acres more or less was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by all the witnesses thereto and together with the Certificate of the proving examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Bernice & Griffen and Susan his wife to James McHenry conveying a tract of Land containing 140 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by Bernice & Griffen and together with the Certificate of the proving examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

5. Deed of trust between Albert W. Brown of the first part Alfred J. Stephenson of the second part and Allen Stephenson of the third part conveying a tract of Land containing 95 Acres more or less, one sowed horse 9 sheats 2 Cows 1 Cart and wherry, Crops of Corn and Golden Oats, Garden bed and furniture and all the remainder of his household and kitchen furniture was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

6. Deed of bargain and sale from Howell & Scarborough to John W. Teller conveying a tract of Land containing 120 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by Howell & Scarborough and admitted to Record.

7. Deed of Trust between Rindell Jackson of the first part James B. Foyner of the second part and James Jackson of the third part conveying One sowed horse 1 sowed mare and sowed geld 22 head of Cattle 35 head of hogs 2 shot guns 2 pair of Cart wherry, bed furniture bed sowed and bridle and all his household and kitchen furniture some black stocks and my crop for the next year, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

8. Deed of bargain and sale from Mills & Lawrence and Solomon Crumpler to George W. Crumpler conveying a tract of Land containing 120 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by Mills & Lawrence and of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

9. Deed of bargain and sale from Mills & Lawrence to William Lawrence conveying a tract of Land containing 100 1/2 Acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th December 1841 by Mills & Lawrence and admitted to Record.
