Deed of Trust between Samuel T. Jones of the first part L R Edwards of the second part and James B. Morris of the third party conveying land and slaves was acknowledged to the office on the 25th February 1832 by
Samuel T. Jones wife of the said James B. Morris before the Justices of the Peace
with the Cognovit thereunto annexed. Summons to Record.

Deed of trust between Samuel T. Jones and George his wife of the first part L R Edwards of the second part
Samuel B. King of the third part conveying Land was acknowledged to the office on the 26th February 1832
and lefted with the Cognovit thereunto annexed before the Justices of the Peace

Deed of Trust between Peter Drury of the first part Abraham A. Drury of the second part and J. H. Moore of the third part was passed in the office on the 17th March 1832 by Anthony Bright Henry Drury and
Sarah Drury subscriber witness thereto were admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from John Higgins to John R. Higgins Conveying personal property was

in the office on the 16th March 1832 by all the parties thereof were admitted to Record.

near Franklin in the name of Orini Vaughan and it is ordered that the usual bonds with them.
