from this day the said Hill to be bound in the sum of \$200 each year. Securitey on the sum  
of \$100 each and that the said Hill also pay the costs of this prosecution. Whereupon the said  
John A Hill with Richard A Vayghart & William Le Pond his Sureties herein Comt  
Ovenally acknowledge themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Lieutenant Governor acting  
as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the sum of \$100 each  
in said Securitey in the sum of \$100 of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be  
levied to the said Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor & his Successors the Office of  
Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon due Consideration of the said John  
A Hill shall keep the peace of good behavior towards all the Citizens of the Commonwealth  
more especially towards Rosella Orrey for the Term of twelve months from this day when this  
recognition to be void.

ghart & William Le Pond his Sureties herein Comt Overyacknowledged themselves  
indebted unto John Rutherford Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of  
Virginia the sum of \$100 each and two Securites in the sum of \$100 each  
of their respective goods & chattels lands & tenements to be levied to the said Governor and his  
Successors in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this  
condition that if the said John A Hill shall keep the peace of good behavior  
towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Barnell  
P Stephenson for the Term of 12 months from this day when this recognition to be void
