 that the said John A. Hill do find Security for keeping the peace for the Term of twelve months
 from this day the said Hill to be bound in the sum of \$200 with 2 Securities in the sum
 of \$100 each and that the said Hill also pay the costs of this prosecution. Whereupon the said
 John A. Hill with Richard A. Verghurst & William C. Bond his Securities here in Court
 solemnly acknowledges themselves indebted unto John Ruthersford Lieutenant Governor acting
 as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the said John A. Hill in the sum of \$200 and
 his said Securities in the sum of \$100 each respectively good & lawful to be levied & Tonnage to be
 levied for the said Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor & his Successors in the Office of
 Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said John
 A. Hill shall keep the peace to of good behavior towards all the Citizens of the Commonwealth
 more especially towards Priscilla Oney for the Term of twelve months from this day then this
 recognizance to be void.

 indebted unto John Ruthersford Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of
 Virginia the said Hill in the sum of \$200 and his said Securities in the sum of \$100 each
 & their respective good & lawful to be levied & Tonnage to be levied for the said Governor and his
 Successors in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this
 condition that if the said John A. Hill shall keep the peace to of good behavior
 towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Priscilla
 P. Stephenson for the Term of 12 months from this day then this recognizance to be void.
