And that the said Newt Branch also pay the costs of this prosecution. Whereupon the said Newt Branch with Milla Pope & Penick Branch his securities here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esq. Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia that to say the said Newt Branch in the sum of \$200. & Milla Pope & Penick Branch and his said securities in the sum of \$100 each of their respective goods & Chattels land and Tenements to be levied and to the said Acting Governor his Successor in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Upon which condition that of the said Newt Branch shall keep the peace & be of good behavior towards all the Citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards the said Bennett P. Stephenson for the Term of twelve months from this day then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

Stephenson for the Term of twelve months from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.

On the motion of James E. Peters against James Moore. It appearing to the Court that the Defendant has had legal notice of this action and he not appearing judgment is granted the plaintiff against the Defendant for \$65.23 cents with Interest from the 11 day of February 1842 till paid &c.
