 William Halsey John H. Siler and George H. Lewis of the third part conveying personal property
 was acknowledged in the office on the 21st day of March 1842 by Morris and Oliver
 two of the parties and submitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Benjamin Higgin and Matthew Harris to Isaac Simpson conveying land was ackn-
 owledged in the office on the 21st of March 1842 by all the parties and submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Lumsden to Thomas Baily conveying land was acknowledged
 in the office on the 21st of March 1842 by said Lumsden and together with the Certificate of
 the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife submitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Benjamin L. Snow and P. M. Bailey to John Crumpton conveying land was
 acknowledged in the office on the 21st of March 1842 by Bailey and Crumpton two of the
 parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas P. Turner and wife to Benjamin Williamson conveying
 land was acknowledged in the office on the 21st of March 1842 by said Turner and together
 with the Certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Vick Crumpton of the John Lewis conveying land was
 acknowledged in the office on the 21st of March 1842 by said Vick and submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Johnson and wife to John Vick conveying
 land was returned to the office on the 21st of March 1842 and together with
 the Certificate thereto annexed submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William H. Nicholson to Joseph Drury conveying

Deed of Trust between Alexander Tate of the first part John Drury of the second part
 and James Drury of the third part conveying land slaves and personal property was acknowledged in
 the office on the 22nd of March 1842 by Tate one of the parties and having been before acknowl-
 edged in said office on 21st day of same month James Drury another party thereto is submitted
 to Record.

Deed of trust between William Midway of the first part John A. Bailey of the second part
 and L. C. Parsons of the third part conveying personal property was acknowledged in the
 office on the 22nd of March 1842 by Midway one of the parties thereto and submitted to Record.
