Deed of trust between Benjamin A. Briggs of the first part Robert Models of the second part and Federal Deles of the third part conveying all the said Briggs interest in Robert Adams Estate was acknowledged in the Office on the 16th day of May 1842 by all the parties thereto granted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from David Williamson, William D. Phillips and Rebecca his wife to Henry Howard conveying land was proved in the Office on the 16th day of May 1842 by all the witnesses thereto and together with the Certificate of the proving examination and acknowledgment of the wives submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John A. Turner of the first part Nicholas de Glens of the second part and John Eney of the third part conveying land Crop of all kinds &c. was acknowledged in the Office on the 14th day of May 1842 by Turner and Glens two of the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Lucy B. Pitney of the first part George Baily of the second part and William Mallory of the third part conveying her the said Lucy B. Pitney interest in the slaves now in possession of Henry Pitney was acknowledged in the Office on the 21st day of May 1842 by Lucy B. Pitney and William Mallory two of the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of Release from James C. Matthews of the first part James James of the second part and Mark A. James of the third part releasing personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 21st day of May 1842 by Matthews and Mark A. James two of the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James James of the first part William L. Edwards of the second part and Joseph T. Edwards of the third part conveying slaves and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 20th day of May 1842 by all the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Matthew W. Vaughan formerly of to Anthony Vaughan conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 1st day of June 1842 by the said Matthew W. Vaughan and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Remond J. Briggs of the first part Lethem B. Edwards of the second part and Edward Bates and John Vick of the third part conveying land, Crop of all kinds was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 1st day of June 1842 by Briggs, Edwards & Bates three of the parties thereto and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between William A. Morris of the first part James A. B. Morris of the second part and William Mallory of the third part conveying all his the said Morris interest in a deed of trust formerly given to Mark A. James and all his Crop of all kinds now was acknowledged in the Office on the 14th day of June 1842 by the said Morris. One of the parties thereto was submitted to Record as to him.

Deed of trust between River Barker of the first part Lethem B. Edwards of the second part and William A. Glens of the third part conveying land slave and personal property was acknowledged in the Office on the 1st day of June 1842 by all the parties thereto and submitted to Record.
