Whereupon it is ordered that a writ of Seque facias be issued against the said Enoch Pratt & his sureties returnable here to the first day of August Term next.

On the motion of Stephen B. Bryant against Mark Taylor assignee of James Taylor dec<sup>d</sup> for Counter Security. The Summons awarded against the said Taylor at May Term last being returned executed and the said Taylor failing to appear it is ordered that the said Taylor give the said Bryant good Counter Security the penalty of which is to be the penalty of the bond executed by the said Taylor for his account - and the said Taylor failing to give the security it is ordered that his duties & powers as assignee be revoked & annulled.
