

On the motion of Elizur Dix & William Brewster against David Newson and Matthew Brewster &c for certain Security - The Court awarded at June Term last not being satisfied it is ordered that a new Summons be awarded against the said Newson & Newson & Brewster to the next Term.

Davis v. Booth. Df'ts. pleased pay now to which the pffr replied generally & the cause is continued till the next Term.

Gurley v. Whithead &c Mo. or f. c. bond. It appearing to the Court that the Df'ts have had legal notice of this motion & they not appearing Judgment is granted the Plaintiff against the Df'ts for the penalty of £5. bond & costs. which execution is to be discharged by the payment of the principal sum due on said bond with Interest from its date till paid Costs.

On the motion of James & Mayfield Ordered that Gubbins R. Edwards who is lawfully appointed Special Law for the purpose shall settle an account on account of the said Mayfield among us & Rose Fells estate & also an account of his account w^t George Williams &c & make report &c.

For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that Eli Joyce, Benjamin Griffis & John Edwards do view the lands through which it is proposed to open a new road commanding near Leip. Bay Griffis to be called the Turners. and Should the Court deem it expedient that the said Road shalld be opened and the Neighbours will open the same. that upon its being reported to the Court the Court will adopt the said road as a public highway.

Liles, Barnes &c v. Holt &c Mo. or f. c. bond. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion and do accordingly Order that the said Lucy Cobb do give Security for keeping the peace for the term of twelve months from this day. that is to say the said Lucy Cobb to be bound in a recognizance in the sum of £50. with two securities in the sum of £25. each and that the said Lucy Cobb pay the costs of this prosecution.
