be added to work on the said road.

John P. Boykin who stands charged with being the father of an child by Matilda Javis a single
woman with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court in discharge of his
obligation. Whereupon by consent of the said John P. Boykin the Court doth adjudge the said
Boykin to be the father of the said bastard child and that the said Child is likely to become chargeable
to the County. Therefore it is ordered that the said John P. Boykin be charged with the amount
for the space of seven years from this day of twenty dollars and that he pay the same to the Overseers of the poor of this County at
the end of every year for the space of seven years from this day in case the Child live so long.
and that the said John P. Boykin pay the costs of this prosecution. Whereupon the said John
P. Boykin with John Boykin his security here in Court severally acknowledge themselves in debt
unto John M. Griggory esq. Lieutenant Governor acting under the provisions of the Constitution
as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said John Boykin in the sum of
One hundred Forty dollars and the said John P. Boykin in the like sum of One hundred Forty
dollars of their respective goods & chattels. Land & tenements to be levied and to the said Lieutenant
Governor acting as Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. (Yet upon this condition
that if the said John P. Boykin shall doove and keep the above order of the Court made against him
that the said recognizance be void or else to remain in full force.

On the motion of Charles Hart. Ordered that Benjamin L. Dore who is hereby appointed
Special Comm. for the purpose do state settle & adjust an account of the said Charles Hart
admission on John Hart or estate. also an account of the said Charles Hart return on James
Hart etc. and make report thereof to Court.

Clarke & Teller vs. W. W. Heard and decree as per decree filed 8th

On the motion of Saml. Muskie for leave to open a new road &c. The Commissioners app^{ts} to
view the way for said road to then this day make report. Whereupon it is ordered that the said
Road as opened be received and established as a public highway.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the present of the road leading from Big
to the Cedar Swamp do stop at the end of the new road joining the Franklin road. And that
the Survey or of the road leading from Franklin to Jerusalem do work to the run of the Cedar
Swamp.

Commonth. v. North &c. &c. For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that this Court do
dismiss and that the Defendants pay the costs thereof.
