Ordered that James Cleaves William A Stephenson & Allen Edwards or any 2 of them do with permission appointed by the County Court of Isle of Wight let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of Old Black water bridge near the same when completed & make report. ^{with leave they may appoint any other persons to do the work}

Ordered that John R Williams, John B Johnson & James Edwards or any 2 of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Franklin Bridge across Black water river ^{with leave they may appoint any other persons to do the work} when completed & make report -

Ordered that Eli Lister, Alexander Lister & John Lister do work as the said judgment of the Court is directed

The Last Will & Testament of Robert Adams dec'd now proved by the oath of Robert B Griffin & John Griffin subscribing witnesses thereto ordered to be recorded -

Ordered that the Sheriff pay to Thomas B Williams the sum of ten pounds for fees & June term last for repairs to the Creek bridge.

On motion of David Drew & William Prince against David Sturson & son Martha Sturson & son for County Security - The Summons awarded at the last term being returned executed and the Dft Stursons not appearing It is ordered that this said David Sturson give the said Drew & Prince good County Security the bond for which purpose is to be executed finally of the bond executed by the said David Sturson as above: as approved and Conditioned according to laws and the said David Sturson failing to give the said bond & Security it is ordered that the process & duties of the said David Sturson as above as approved be notified & executed.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Dft bond Drew & Prince - an apportion free wages to Samuel J Jones according to Law - that the said James pay annually to the Dft the sum of ten dollars during the apprenticeship of the said Men Seabor - except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentices -

Ordered that the Justices of this County be summoned to the first day of October next to elect a Clerk of the Court to supply the vacancy soon to be created by the expiration of the term of the present Clerk.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon the Justices of this County to the next term of the Court to consider the application of James B Wigham for leave to set aside a portion of the Highway.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the Justices of this County to October term next to recommend other persons to be appointed Commissioners Justices of this County -
