- Deed of bargain and sale from David Lewis and his wife Eliza Allen Edwards & his wife Eliza and Deborah Turner of the one part and Benjamin Griffin of the other part conveying land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 17th day of September 1842 by one of the witnesses and having been before proved by two of the other witnesses thereto is together with the certificate of the party examination and acknowledgement of the parties admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between William D. Phillips of the first part John M. Curley of the second part and James D. Bryant of the third part Conveying land and the following slaves and other personal property to wit Negro man Billy, Terry, Harry, Jefie, woman Cuba negro girl Patty and their future increase, horses, hogs, sheep and cattle and their future increase bed and furniture chairs kitchen furniture, farming utensils, growing crop of Corn, Cotton, up to Fall, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 19th day of September 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between William Vick of the first part Thomas Diggs of the second part and John Green Stony of the third part Conveying Cider Barrels, Corn, fodder, beds and furniture and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 19th day of Sept. 1842 by Vick, & Doyle two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between John H. Woodford of the first part James McLeomor of the second part and Alexander McLeomor of the third part Conveying horses, cattle, beds and furniture chairs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 19th day of Sept. 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Release from Bennett St. Whitfield and John Hargrove to William H. Cutler releasing a certain tract of land was proved in the Clerks Office the 19th day of Sept. 1842 by the owner of three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of bargain and sale from William H. Cutler of the one part and Gordon Cattoe of the other part conveying one certain Tract of Land and his interest in two other tracts of Land known by the name of the Piney grove and Tugason tracts also all his growing crop of all kinds was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 19th day of Sept. 1842 by the said William H. Cattoe and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between William J. Cotton of the first part John Drury of the second part and S. and J. Drury of the third part Conveying slaves, horses, cattle, hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 20th day of Sept. 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between William H. Cutler of the first part A. & R. Cutler of the second part and William Borden of the third part Conveying beds and furniture Table, chest and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 21st day of Sept. 1842 by the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between Thomas Moran son and Elizabeth P. his wife of the first part Thos. D. Moran junior of the second part and Milton J. Brown of the third part Conveying crop of corn and fodder was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 29th day of Sept. 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.
- Deed of Trust between James S. Hudson of the first part John Drury of the second part and Henry Pettway of the third part conveying horses, mire & saddle and other personal property was
