Deed of Trust between Matthew C. Beal of the first part, James M. Agot of the second part and John Borrett & Henry Simond of the third part, conveying his own interest in the land of land on which she now lives, one negro girl, feather beds & other personal property was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 11th day of October 1842 by one of the witnesses and before proved by two other witnesses and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Warden Scholler of the first part, Littleton R. Edwards of the second part and Joseph C. Muddough of the third part, conveying land & hogs was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by one of the witnesses and having been before proved by two other witnesses was admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Joseph A. Edson to Emma Beal, conveying his interest in a certain tract of land called & known by the name of the Marshfield land as was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the said J^r A. Edson & admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between William V. Cotton of the first part, James M. Blawie of the second part and William Malloy & J^r C. Petrus of the third part, conveying two negro men, horses, cattle, hogs & other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the said William V. Cotton a party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from James Drury & wife to Isaac Coffey, conveying land & coal was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by James Drury a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife, admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from James H. Love to Matthew Williams, conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the said J^r H. Love & admitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Jonathan T. Griffin and Jacob Barnes to Benjamin Barnes, releasing land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the said Griffin & Barnes and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Nathanael Whitfield of the first part, Jonathan T. Griffin of the second part and Bennett Barrett of the third part, conveying horse, negroes, hogs, cattle, hogs & other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Robert Marshall of the first part, William A. Jones of the second part & Joseph T. Blount of the third part, conveying land, cattle & other personal property was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the witnesses as to two of the parties thereto & was acknowledged by the other party thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between John Warren of the first part, William R. Stephenson of the second part and Allen Stephenson of the third part, conveying horse, cattle, cart wheels & other personal property was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of October 1842 by the witnesses thereto & admitted to Record.
