On the motion of John D. Maylor who made oath & gave bond & security as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John D. Barrett did in due form.

On the motion of Dr. William A. Mafsenburg ordered that Thomas Lawrence guardian of Joanne Schabid forbear out of the principal of the estate estate payable said Mafsenburg the sum of £23 50 cents the amount of his account, the interest & profits of the estate being insufficient for the purpose.

On the motion of Richard Barrett & Eder and (for amplification ordered that Lydia Barrett, James W. Marple & for said Eder and, divide the negroes belonging to the estate of Wella Muske die between Martha M. Connerly & Amanda Louise Betty Ellen Barrett as directed by the will of the Lord and make report to the Court.

Ordered that Henry Pottery Benja Applenwhite Boesham Whinn & Thos Whinn let the repairs of Lents bridge across the stone creek receive the same when complete & make up out.

Ordered that the overseers of the poor find Lydia Evans daughter of James Evans for to River Barton according to Law the said River Barton paying for the services of the said Lydia the sum of ten dollars annually from the time of her arrival at the age of 12 years to the age of eighteen years except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that Henry P. Briggs John Simmons John A. Turner & Elijah Nelson or any three to appraise the estate of James Ball dec'd & return the same.

John Taylor who is in custody of the Sheriff at the suit of Saml J. Longles who sues for the benefit of John M. Gurley by virtue of an execution sent out of the Court was brought into Court & thereupon he submitted & delivered in a schedule of his estate & made oath according to Law whereupon it is ordered that he be discharged from custody if detained for no other cause than the execution aforesaid.
