On the motion of Jeptha Parker who made oath of his will of security according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Cook die in due form.

On the motion of John D. Maylor who made oath of his will of security as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Cook die in due form.

On the motion of Dr. William et al Mapenbury Ordered that Thomas Lawrence guardian of Joanne Schabt get out of the principal of the estate of Dr. William et al Mapenbury the sum of \$23.50 less the amount of his account, the interest & profits of the estate being insufficient for the purpose.

On the motion of Richard Barrett & Edward Conant Order that George Newson, James W. Marfie & Jordan Edwards divide the negroes belonging to the estate of Hello Marfie die between Martha M. Conant & Annanda Louise Dyer alias Barrett as directed by the will of the dec'd and make report to the Court.

Ordered that Henry Bellamy Benja Applewhite Barker & Hiram Hennet & Thos Hennet let the repairs of shorts bridge across the stream receive the same when complete & make up out.

Ordered that the overseers of the poor bind Lydia Evans daughter of James Evans to River Barker according to Law the said River Barker paying to the overseers of the said Lydia the sum of ten dollars annually from the time of her arrival at the age of 12 years to the age of eighteen years except for the last year which is to be paid to the apprentice.

Ordered that Henry P. Briggs John Simmons John A. Turner & Elijah Nelsons many three to appraise the Estate of James Bell die & return the same to Dr.

John Taylor who is in custody of the Sheriff at the suit of Sam'l Douglass who sue for the benefit of John M. Curing by virtue of an Execution sued out of the Court was brought into Court & thereupon he subscribed & delivered in a Schedule of his Estate & made oath according to Law whereupon it is ordered that he be discharged from custody if detained for no other cause than the execution aforesaid.
