Pullen & ad to Pullen admr refunding bond acknowledged & ordered to be recorded

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On motion of Settleton R. Edwards blmo of this Court Edwin D. Nash is
 permitted to qualify as his Deputy during his pleasure and thereupon
 said Nash took the oaths required by law

Ordered that John R. Williams John B. Smith Jesse Parker Harrison Jesse
 or any three of them ~~of the~~ be sworn to appraise the estate of David Nash
 decd & return the same

Mrs L. Everett Samuel B. Hines and Jephtha Darden are unanimously
 recommended to the Governor to execute the office of Sheriff of this County
 the ensuing year

John M. Gurley & Paul Kell generally gave bond & security as comrs
 of the Revenue which bond was acknowledged & ordered to be recorded

Rein R. Travis who hath been delivered up by his Special Bail at the
 Suit of J. Y. Mason was brought into Court and subpoenaed & shown
 in a habeas corpus of his Estate & made oath & thereupon It is ordered
