Williams, conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842 by William Joyner a party thereto and together with the certificate of the privy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Miles L. B. of the first part, Thomas D. Knight of the second part, Jacob Williams, Matthew R. B. of the third part, and Sampson Pope of the third part, conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Gray, Williams and Matthew R. Pope, three of the parties thereto, and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Jeremiah Chappell of the first part, Thomas J. Butler of the second part and Thomas Butlers of the third part, conveying land and one half of a mill & part, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Chappell and Thomas J. B. conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842 by Caswell Morrill a party thereto, and together with the certificate of the privy examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Peter Pope to William R. Morrill conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 22nd day of November 1842 by the said Peter Pope and admitted to record.
