admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain & sale from Thomas Everett wife To Burnell Everett conveying  
land was proved by the oath of James Mudgett & Alia Myrick two of the wit-  
nesses thereto and in the Clerks Office the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December 1842 the deed was  
acknowledged by Thomas Everett a party thereto and together with the certificate  
of the joint examination & acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills D Summer and wife of the first part James A Schrell of the  
second part, Nicholas M Schrell and Thomas C Jones of the third part conveying land
