Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas Everett & wife To Bunwell Everett conveying land, was proved by the oaths of James Magist & Alex Myonick two of the witnesses thereto, and in the Clerk's Office the 24th day of December 1842 this deed was acknowledged by Thomas Everett a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills D Sumner and wife of the first part, James A Sebell of the second part, Nicholas M Sebell and Thomas C Jones of the third part, conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 28th day of December 1842 by Mills D Sumner a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination & acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.
