 in forging a bond against Joseph Leon. James Leon & Francis Leon the
 day appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizances entered into before
 Justice of the Peace for this County (the Court summoned for his appearance be-
 ing failed to meet) And was set to the bar in custody of the Justice of the County
 of Southampton On the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth the Court
 of the said Just Leon is adjourned till the next Court in case to be held in this
 County And thereupon on the motion of the said Just Leon he is allowed to
 give bail himself to be bound in the sum of five hundred dollars with two
 sureties in the sum of two hundred fifty dollars each for his personal appearance
 before the Justice of this Court at the next term thereof - Whereupon the said
 Just Leon together with Miles W Lawrence & Charles D Gardner
 his sureties here in Court solemnly acknowledged themselves indebted unto James
 M'Donnell esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia the Receiver in
 Office that is to say the said Just Leon in the sum of five hundred dollars and
 the said Miles W Lawrence & Charles D Gardner - in the sum of two hundred
 and fifty dollars each of their respective goods & chattels lands & Personals to be law-
 fully rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Just Leon shall make
 his personal appearance before the Justice of the County Court of Southampton at
 the Court house thereof on the first day of the next Term of the said Court then and
 there to abide such order as shall be made against him the said Leon of and
 concerning the felony whereby he stands charged in forging a bond against Joseph
 Leon James Leon & Francis Leon and shall not depart therefrom without
 leave of the said Court then the above recognizance to be void & he to remain in pris-
 on for -

Francis Leon John W Belland & Henrietta Belland who have been summoned
 to appear here this day as next of kin in behalf of the Commonwealth against Just Leon
 were solemnly called but came not Therefore it is ordered that they be sum-
 moned to appear here at the next Term to shew cause why they should not be fined
 for this said Contempt.
