

Ordered that Alexander Myrick, William A. Hill, Bennett, Bennett & Henry O'Gorman
a company of their being sued & appear before the general estate of Russell Everett do &
such intent of

William L. Everett who hath been Commissioner Sheriff of this County by a Commission
from the Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor with the seal of the Commonwealth annexed
bearing date the 2d day of November 1842, this day appeared in Court & entered into a
suitable bond in the penalty of \$30,000 each conditioned as the law directs which bonds
were acknowledged by the obligors thereto named & Ordered to be recorded. The said Will-
iam Everett also qualified to the said Commission by taking the Oath with the present-
ing by Law.

The Commissioners appointed to let the repair of First bridge this day made their report
that sum of money appointed to let the alteration of the Road on the South side of
the Village River near Jessen's Corners this day made report whereupon the Court did
establish the new road as a public highway. & ordered that the old road be discontinued.

sureties entered into his & acknowledged a bond according to the above Order.

The Court doth adjudge Gilpin Edwards guardian to Emma Vaughan entitled of
John Vaughan and therefore the said Gilpin Edwards gave bond of security accord-
ing to Law.

James A. Smith et al heirs of Ichabod Smith with the approbation of the Court make claim
of Theodore Tugent for her guardian & therefore the said Tugent gave bond of security accord-
ing to Law.

For reasons appearing to the Court the Order made at the last Court disengaged
J. Bailey minor of James Scott esq^r to pay Mrs. Griffis & others sum of which the
real estate of James Scott esq^r is set aside. And it is ordered that Anna J. Porter
minor of Anna Prudon esq^r pay the Commissioner the sum of money directed by the
aforesaid Order.

On the motion of Michael M. Gibell who made oath of good bond & security making
to Law Certificate granted him for Master of Administration on the estate of
Henry Lawrence died in due form.
