William L. Everett who hath been Comptroller Sheriff of this County by a Commission from the Court of Sessions acting as Governor with the seal of the Comptroller under bearing date the 24th day of November 1822. this day appeared in Court & entered into several bonds in the penalty of \$30,000 each conditioned as the Law directs, which bonds were acknowledged by the obligors therein named & Ordered to be recorded. The said William L. Everett also qualified to the said Comptroller by taking the Oath of office &c

On the motion of Jesse Sanford against Alfred Hicks guardian to John Prutton & Henry Prutton officers of Joseph Prutton dec'd for Counter Security. This day came the parties or their proper persons also being heard it is Ordered that the said Alfred Hicks give the said Jesse Sanford good Counter Security the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of \$30,000 and Conditioned as the Law directs. Whereupon the said Alfred Hicks ~~acknowledged~~ J. D. Maysburg, Ebenezer Richdon & Henry D. Stone his sureties entered into & acknowledged a bond according to the above order.

The Court doth assign William Edwards guardian to Susan Vaughan orphan of Anthony Vaughan and thereupon the said William Edwards gave bond & Security according to Law.

Frances A. Smith officer of Isaac Smith with the approbation of the Court made claim of Gordon Inquest for her guardian & thereupon the said Inquest gave bond and Security according to Law.

For reasons appearing to the Court. The Order made at the last Term directing Alfred Prutton, son of James Scott dec'd to pay Henry Griffith & others loan, who claimed the real estate of James Scott dec'd is set aside. And it is ordered that Thomas J. Prutton son of Ann Prutton dec'd pay the Comptroller the claims of money due by the above Order.

On the motion of Nicholas W. Seibert who made oath & gave bond & Security according to Law Certificate is granted him for receiving letters of administration on the estate of Henry Lawrence dec'd in due form.

The registers of Elijah Abbot, Sum. Brown, Martha Chaffey, Richard Allen, Buggy Allen & Alfred Hicks free negroes, were examined & certified to be truly made.
