Deed of bargain and sale from William D'Hoed (acting as trustee) to Phineas M. Bailey
conveying James Harts interest in a certain tract of land and negro slave, was acknowledged
in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said D'Hoed and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Samuel Stille and wife to John W. Johnson, conveying land
was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by Samuel Stille and
wife, and together with the certificate of the party examination & acknowledgement of the wife
admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John M. Beale of the first part, William R. Bryant of the second part
and Richard A. Belote of the third part, conveying one horse & one bid, &c. was acknowledged
in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by John M. Beale a party thereto and admitted
to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Robert Raigard and wife to Hordeine Brailshaw con-
veying land, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by
Robert Raigard a party thereto, and together with the certificate of the party examination &
acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust from Johnson Raigard and his wife, Charles Gilbold and William
Raigard to Hordeine Brailshaw, Conveying land, was proved in the Clerks Office the 16th
day of January 1843 by the oaths of Benjamin Griffin, William G. Stephenson & Gordon G. Griffin
the witness thereto is together with the certificate of the party examination and acknowledgement
of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Josiah D. M. Dolk of the first part, John R. Briggs of the second part
and Joseph Puller of the third part, Conveying a female slave, was acknowledged
in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by Dolk & Briggs two of the parties thereto
and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Drury Special Servt. &c. To Joseph T. Cloud con-
veying land, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Drury
and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Allen B. Marfa to Nathaniel Purvis, conveying his
Master's interest in Piggy Story &c. Estate, was proved in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January
1843 by the oaths of John Booth and Charles Fullerton two of the witnesses thereto admitted
to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edith Brailshaw to Benjamin Griffin, Conveying land
was proved in the Clerks Office the 21st day of November 1842 by the oath of Samuel
Helle and Jamesinck Chapman two of the witnesses thereto and in the Clerks Office the 16th
day of January 1843 this deed was proved by the oath of Albridge Brailshaw an-
other witness thereto is admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain & sale from John Vick to Sam Stille, conveying land was acknowledged
in the Clerks Office the 16th day of January 1843 by John Vick a party thereto together with the
certificate of the party examination & acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.
