conveying James Harts interest in a certain tract of land and more there, was acknowledged
in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Hood and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Samuel Wells and wife to John D Johnson conveying land

and Joseph Puller of the third part, conveying a female slave, was acknowledged
in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by Dalk & Briggs two of the parties thereto
and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Drury Special Constable to Joseph T. Cloud convey-
ing land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of January 1843 by said Drury
and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Allen B. Murphree to Nathaniel Francis, conveying his
Murphree interest in Peggy Story's Estate, was proved in the Clerk's Office the 16th day of Jan-
uary 1843 by the oaths of John Booth and Charles Fuller two of the witnesses thereto & admitted
to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Edith Bradsheaw to Benjamin Griffin, conveying land
was proved in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of November 1842, by the oaths of Samuel
Wells and Jeremiah Chappell two of the witnesses thereto and in the Clerk's Office the 16th
day of January 1843, this deed was proved by the oath of Albridge W Bradsheaw one
of the witnesses thereto is admitted to Record.
