Whitcomb, Charles Kuttus, William Carter and others creditors of the said Solomon I. Barham of the third part, conveying negro slaves, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 23rd day of January 1843, by Barham, Edwards, Gurley & Mahon four of the parties heirs and admitted to Record

Deed of trust between Benjamin Brown of the first part, Clements Rockwell of the second part, and James M. (a negro) of the third part conveying land, negro slaves, horses, cattle, hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 25th day of January 1843, by all the parties heirs & admitted to Record

Deed of bargain and sale from Thomas S. Patton to Thomas Patton conveying Land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 28th day of January 1843, by said Thomas S. Patton and admitted to Record

Deed of trust between Arthur B. Maget of the first part, Everett Carr of the second part, and George Atchump (a negro) of the third part, conveying a negro slave, horse, cattle, hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 1st day of February 1843 by all the parties heirs and admitted to Record

Deed of bargain and sale from Joseph J. Williams to William J. Williams conveying his (J. J. W.) interest in a certain tract of land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 2nd day of February 1843 by said J. J. Williams and admitted to Record

Deed of trust between John H. Reese of the first part, Mark J. Pate of the second part, and Sampson C. Reese, Nathaniel Fannin, John Dancy & Henry Moore all of the third part, conveying Land, negro slaves, horses, cattle and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 3rd day of February 1843 by John H. Reese, Mark J. Pate two of the parties heirs and admitted to Record

Deed of trust between William J. Williams of the first part, Grant J. Williams of the second part and Thomas S. Patton of the third part, conveying his (W. J. Williams) interest in a certain tract of land, including the interest in the widows dower but Matthew Williams & Co. and one negro slave was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 4th day of February 1843 by all the parties heirs and admitted to Record

Deed of bargain & sale from John H. Booth to Edward Beale, conveying his Booth's interest in the estate of Peter Booth dec^d was proved in the Clerk's Office the 7th day of January 1843 by the oath of Williams A. Bell a witness thereto and in the Clerk's Office the 2nd day of February 1843 this deed was proved by the oath of Phineas A. R. Riddley another witness thereto & admitted to Record

Deed of trust between Ray Brown of the first part, Peter Edwards, John Whitehead and Nathaniel Jones of the second and David H.
