Jacob Leroy who stands charged with felony in forging a bond against Joseph Leroy James Leroy & Francis Leroy this day appears in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into at the last Term and was set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and thereupon sundry witnesses were sworn & examined as well on behalf of the Crown as of the prisoner & the prisoner was heard in his defence by counsel, the Court after hearing the testimony & from all the circumstances of the case was of opinion & do therefore order that the said Jacob Leroy be discharged from further prosecution for the said supposed offence and therefore the said Jacob Leroy is discharged from custody.

Upon the deposition of reading a plat against mill on the yellow swamp in this County on the application of Robert & Andrew Bolling further that he is the owner of the land on the East side of the Yellow swamp in this County and that Mary White, Charles Bull, John Moore & William Edwards are owners of the land on the opposite of the said stream. And it appearing to the Court that the said Mary White, Charles Bull, John Moore & William Edwards have had two suppressive notices of this application they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is ordered that a writ of ad quod damnum be given to the Sheriff of this County directed to be executed according to law on the 15th day of March next which writ together with this inquest to be made on process and return of it to be returned to the next Court.
