Deed of bargain and sale from John McFalland and wife James D. Deneque, William Carr, Henry May & Donqu and Francis P. Ralls in right of his wife Emma late Emma Deneque conveying Land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1848 by John McFalland a party thereto and together with the certificate of the private examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.
