Gany and Sally Johnson two of the parties thereto and together with the certificate of the privy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John McHolland and wife James D. Denegre, William C. Denegre Mary D. Denegre and Francis O.
