Deed of bargain and sale from Albert W. Nicholson to George A. W. Newson conveying Land, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 25th day of March 1843 by said Nicholson and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Elijah Nelson and wife of the first part James W. Parker of the second part and Henry B. Vaughan of the third part conveying Land was a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record. And in the Clerks Office the 27th day of March 1843, this indenture was acknowledged by James W. Parker another party thereto.

Bill of Sale from Sonak to Smith to James W. Muspi conveying a negro slave was proved in the Clerks Office the 30th day of March 1843 by the oaths of James Mospenburg and Edward to Muspi the witnesses thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Joseph C. Munday and wife to Daniel Adams conveying Land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 31st day of March 1843 by J. C. Munday a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Joseph C. Munday and wife to Elizabeth of self conveying Land, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 31st day of March 1843 by J. C. Munday a party thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Thomas D. Wright Jacob Williams and Sampson Cooper to Wells (Green) releasing Land, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 31st day of March 1843, by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between John Simmons of the first part William J. Sebrell of the second part and Edwards Beale of the third part conveying Land, negro slaves, horse cattle, hogs and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 1st day of April 1843 by Simmons and Sebrell two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record. And in the Clerks Office the 5th day of April 1843 this indenture was acknowledged by Edwards Beale the other party thereto.

Deed of bargain and sale from George Wendall and wife to John Richardson conveying Land was returned in the Clerks Office the 5th day of April, and together with the certificate thereto announced of their acknowledgment before two Justices of the Peace admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Samuel S. Nicholson of the first part Edwin Nash of the second part and George A. W. Newson and John W. Rochelle of the third part conveying two horses, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 5th day of April 1843, by Nicholson and Nash two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Martha Whitefield, Garrison D. D. Speer and Jacob Barnes conveying Land was proved in the Clerks Office the 20th day of March 1843 by the oaths of J. Darrow and William Drake two of the witnesses thereto. And in the Clerks Office the 5th day of April 1843, this indenture was proved
