who stand charged with felony their respective names to be void or else to remain in full  
force & virtue -

bers witnesses thereof & ordered to be recorded. And on the petition of Dicy Pope the Executrix  
showing names who made oath and gave bond and Security according Law certificate is granted  
her for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form -

all the personal estate of Matthew R. Pope dec'd & deliver the same &c.
