Ordered that George A. Watson, Fielding J. Mahone & Wm. S. Goodenough at any time be them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the enclosure around the public Square in the same when completed & make report.

Ordered that the hands of Francis J. Kelly, William M. Conant & Benjamin J. Wall do work on the road of which John J. Jenkins is Surveyor.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
