Deed of trust between Nathaniel Chamberlain of the first part William D. Clarke of the second part and Harrison P. Pope of the third part conveying horse traps traps traps and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by Chamberlain & Pope two of the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between George Stony of the first part William D. Clarke of the second part and Harrison P. Pope of the third part conveying Basin corn fields horse traps and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by Stony and Pope two of the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Wilton Gay of the first part John J. Goddins of the second part and William Judkins of the third part conveying negro horses cattle traps and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by Gay and J. J. Goddins two of the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Anthony Woodard of the first part John McCarley of the second part and Joseph J. Clouds of the third part conveying said Woods entire interest both in the real and personal estate of Samuel Woodard dead was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by all the parties trustees and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John H. Miller and wife to Robert Rowland conveying said land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by John H. Miller party trustee and together with the certificate of the living recompensation of a slave segment of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Mary A. A. Brock to James J. Williams conveying her interest in the tract of land formerly belonged to Coggs Drake was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843 by said Mr. Brock trustee and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Fustard T. Ridley to William W. Everett conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17th day of April 1843.
