Ordered that Wiley Parker the Commissioner in this cause be summoned to appear here on the first day of June next next in this cause of any he can, why an attachment should not be issued against him for his contempt in failing to comply with the order made in this cause at January Term last.

The accounts pursuant to the report of John Dewart and on Benjamin Phillips et. of the estate of Susan Phillips et. and of his guardianship of William B. Richards having, severally been audited and no exception being filed was confirmed & ordered to be recorded.

Account pursuant to the report of Benjamin Griffiths et. on Ridley D. Cooks estate was returned and ordered to lie on the Court for exceptions.

On motion of John Dewart and of Gregory Rindings et. Ordered that James J. Parker et. of Solomon D. Parkers et. removed before Stephen R. Edwards (who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose) an account of the said Solomon D. Parkers et. on Gregory Rindings et. which occurred the said Court is directed to examine state & settle & make report thereof to Court.

On motion of James J. Parker et. of Solomon D. Parkers et. Ordered that Stephen R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose do state & settle and adjust an account of Solomon D. Parkers et. on Charles Carolina et. & make report thereof to Court.

Accounts Current of John W. Gurley and proceedings on John W. Dumas et. & of Jonathan Dardens et. on William Dumas et. were returned & ordered to lie on the Court for exceptions.

On motion of Abraham Giverson. Ordered that Mr. Giverson do examine state & settle and account of said Giverson et. on John Popes estate and report thereon to Court.

Account of John W. Gurley et. on John Popes estate was returned & ordered to be recorded.

The Court appointed to let the repairs of the small bridge near Franklin the day made their report which is ordered to be recorded.

The order made last Court directing the Court to send Joe Ricks for negro to Elizabeth Nelson is amended in this that she shall bind Charles Ricks to said negro.

Ordered that Justice Munroe, Miles W. Lawrence, James J. Morris & Jordan Edwards a majority of them, ~~the~~ the Court appointed by the County Court of Accomack in settling the repairs of the bridge at Piquoy creek Blackwater River receive the same when completed & make report.

Ordered that John Parker, Seth D. Williams, H. Morrison & John L. L. to the Court and ordered the repairs or rebuilding of the bridge at Summit bridge, receive the same when completed & make report.
