87. 86. Barham v Sands Esq. Blay. This case, this significant one by the Court in the

On motion of James L. Taylor. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes & of
his negro Jack in future he being aged & infirm.

On motion of James Vicks guardian of Marya Marcella Mary Williams & Susan
Joyner. Ordered that he be permitted to collect \$20 each of the principal of each of his
words stated, independent of the interest & profits, for their disbursements & for the year 1841 & 1842.

87. Silvy Bobb who has de bene by recognition for his appearance have to answer the Complaint of
Simon Murfee against him for a breach of the peace appeared on discharge of his recognizance
whereupon it is ordered that the said Complaint be dismissed and that the said Simon Murfee the
prosecutor pay the costs of this prosecution.

On the motion of Robert B. Brinson who is desirous of building a water gate mill and
dam across the Murray Swamp in this County and setting forth that he is the owner of
the lands on both sides the said stream at the place where he wishes to erect the said mill and
dam. a writ of ad quod damnum is awarded him to the Sheriff of this County to be directed to
be executed according to law on the 15th day of June next which writ with regular return
is requested to be taken in pursuance thereof, is to be returned to the next Court.

Whitfield v. Whitfield Esq. Blay. Decree awarded as per annexed decree filed

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
