Deed of bargain and sale from John R. Rochelle to William D. Wilson conveying Land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 15th day of May 1843. by latter said John R. Rochelle and submitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Jacob Bryant of the first part Harrison Joyner of the second part and Mary A Daughtery of the third part conveying land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 15th day of May 1843 by Bryant and Joyner two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Solomon Fletcher to Thomas Pittman conveying land was proved in the Clerk's Office the 20th day of March 1843 by the oath of Arthur Booth another trustee and in the Office the 6th day of May 1843 the said deed was proved by the oath of Mulloy & Gwaltney another witness trustee and in the Office on the 15th day of May 1843 the said deed was proved by Joshua Tappan who made oath that he and Solomon Fletcher acknowledge the same to be his act and deed, whereupon the said deed ^{was} admitted to Records.

Deed of trust between Robert Marshall of the first part, James H. Sykes of the second part and Joseph T. Claud of the third part conveying this mortgage, entire order of even 50 Cent and whole, gave and after personal property was a known 4650 in the Clerk's Office the 15th day of May 1843 by Claud a party trustee and was sworn as to before another party trustee by the oath of Wm. Sykes and Kewitt Drew and was to Marshall the other party trustee by the oath of John M. Garley Sykes & Drew the witnesses trustee and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from James Johnson and wife to John B. Jenkins conveying land was proved in the Clerk's Office the 17 day of April 1843 by the oath of Jeph. Barker and H. T. Smith two of the witnesses thereto. And in the Office on the 16th day of May 1843. The said deed was proved by the oath of James B. Jenkins the other witness thereto & together with the certifi- cate of the jury ^{and} confirmation and acknowledgment of the wife ^{and} admitted to Record

Quod of trust from Drury Little to James D Westbrooke conveying 1/2 of corn of odder and
puttin beds, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st day of May 1843. by said Little
and James D Westbrooke, two of the parties thereto and admitted to R. & O.

Deed of trust between William Davis of the first part, Thomas Deek, of the second part, and John H. Davis of the third part conveying land, beds go herewith and kitchen furniture and other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th day of May 1813, by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record
