ing to Edwin Reese estate, also his interest in the purchasable estate was acknowledged in the
Clerk's Office the 11th day of July 1843 by said Teltz and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Seneca C. Smith of the first part Seth D. Williams of the second part
and Hanning F. Smith of the third part, conveying lands, slave, cattle & other personal
property was acknowledged in the Office the 11th day of July 1843 by Seneca C. Smith
two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between John A. Darden of the first part Seth D. Williams of the second part
& Hanning F. Smith of the third part, conveying horses, cattle, hog, and other personal prop-
erty was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of July 1843 by A. Darden
party thereto and was proved by the oath of A. Darden a witness thereto to be true
another party thereto. And in the Office the 3rd day of July 1843, the said Deed was
proved by the oath of Wm. Conner another witness thereto to be true and in said Office
the 11th day of July 1843 the said Deed was acknowledged by said Darden a party thereto
& admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Norman Holland of the first part, Meredith Holland of the second
part and Henry Fowler of the third part, conveying crop, corn, grass was acknowledged
in the Office in the 11th day of July 1843 by Norman & Meredith Holland two of the parties
thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Mills Spe of the first part Edwight Nash of the second part and
Richard Darden of the third part, conveying land, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office
the 11th day of July 1843, by all the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William Soyars and wife to Hanning Deal, conveying land, was ac-
knowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of July 1843 by Wm. Soyars & party thereto and
together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledged in the Clerk's Office
admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Thomas M. Murrell of the first part James McLeath of the second part and
Hargrave and Chappell and others of the third part, conveying crop of corn, grass, cattle &
& other personal property was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of July 1843 by
said Murrell, J. McLeath & Hargrave & Chappell two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between James Williams of the first part William P. Moore of the second
part and Abram R. Edrick of the third part, conveying land, horse, cattle, grass, and
other personal property, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 11th day of July 1843
by said Williams & R. Edrick two of the parties thereto & admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Ethelred Edwige of the first part Edwight Nash of the second part
and George A. M. Newson of the third part, conveying slaves was acknowledged in the
Office the 11th day of July 1843 by Edwige & Nash two of the parties thereto &
admitted to Record.
